
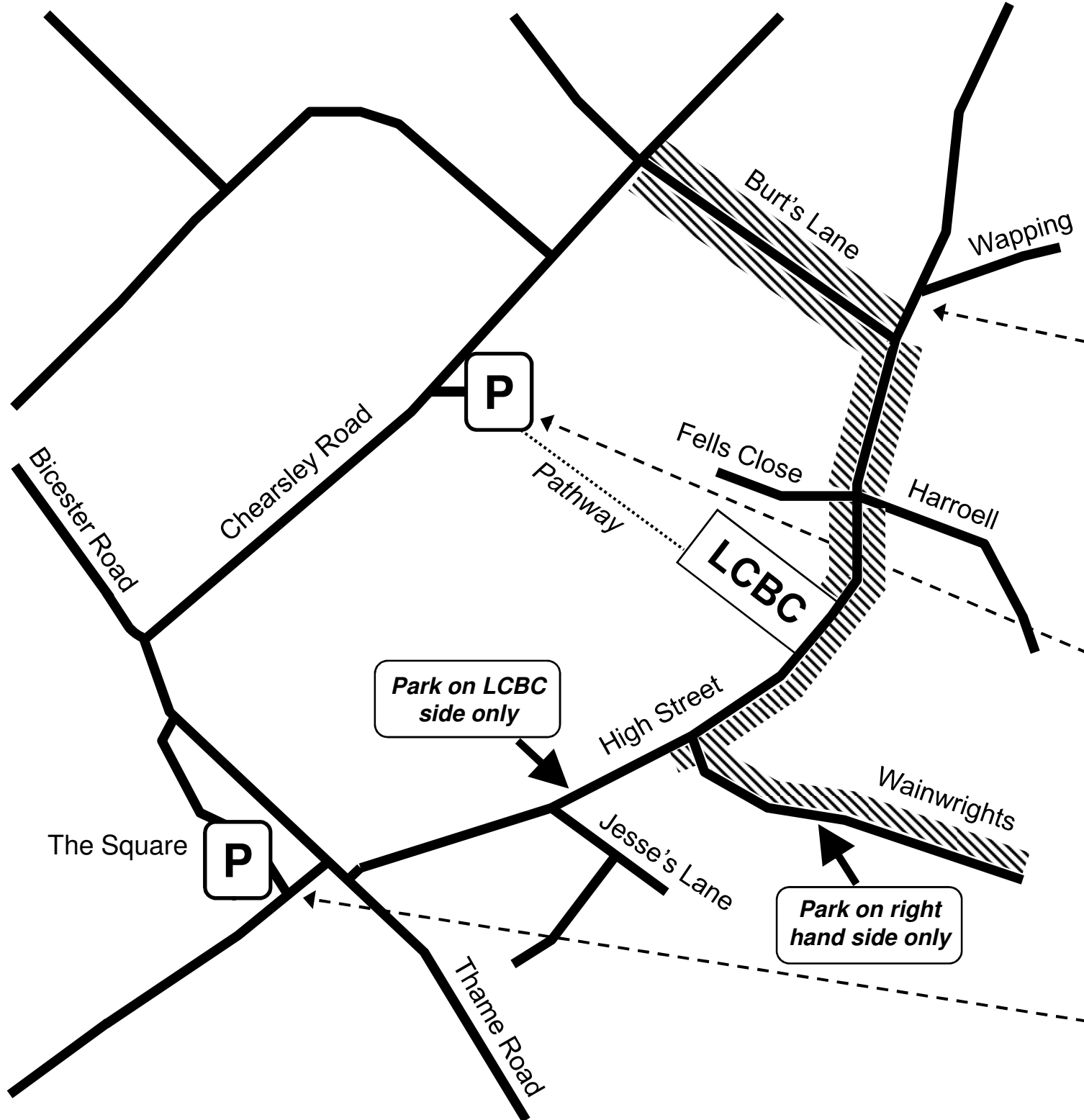


Parking for LCBC

Please avoid parking on sides marked  as the road is narrow and/or entrances are restricted.



- There may be some parking spaces on the right where the High Street widens, but please do not block access to Wapping.

Public car parks within walking distance:

- The car park by the pavilion (access from Chearsley Road), but please give priority to Rec users if there is a match being played.
Note: You can drop-off and pick up from here for our youth activities during the week.

A Good Parking Guide for Long Crendon Baptist Church

LCBC is a lively church, with over two hundred people attending on Sundays, and offers a wide variety of events during the week for all ages.

Both church and village existed long before the car. As a consequence, parking is limited and care is needed to ensure harmony between church users and those who live close by.

Before making a car journey to LCBC, it is worth asking if the car is necessary. Could you walk or cycle? Is it possible to share a lift with someone else? Is there someone you know in whose driveway you could park?

The church runs liftshare and driveway sharing schemes on Sunday mornings:

Contact the church office for details.

If using the car is necessary, please follow the information shown overleaf. Consider others, such as people who live and park in the area or those who may need to park nearer than you.

If picking up or dropping off, please do not double-park and restrict traffic flow. For our youth activities, you could also use the car park by the Rec (access off Chearsley Road) to drop off and pick up - this will reduce the volume of traffic in the High Street during those peak times.

If parking in the High Street, please park only on the same side as the church and try and avoid parking between the church and Burts Lane as the road is narrower here. In particular, avoid parking directly opposite Harroell at any time - this will mean cars can pull in and allow passing at that point.

If parking in Wainwrights, please park on the right hand side only - giving good consideration to homes and garage block access and leave space to allow passing.

When parking, please remember the Highway Code guidance on parking:

- Park as close as you can to the side of the road
- Do not park on pavements
- Do not park opposite another parked vehicle if this would cause an obstruction
- Do not park in front of an entrance to a property or hinder access
- Do not stop too close to a vehicle displaying a Blue Badge – they may need more access room
